

## OVERVIEW OF THE MALAYSIAN OIL PALM INDUSTRY IN 2025

### FOREWORD

The Malaysian oil palm industry registered a strong performance in 2025, underpinned by higher production, sustained price levels and resilient export earnings. Crude palm oil (CPO) production reached a historic milestone of 20.28 million tonnes; the highest level recorded in a decade. With the exception of exports, all other key indicators registered growth during the period.

Oil palm planted area expanded modestly by 1.6% to 5.70 million hectares from 5.61 million hectares in 2024, mainly attributed to the expansion of immature palm areas following the implementation of replanting activities. The record-high CPO production represented a 4.9% increase from 19.34 million tonnes in 2024, supported by stronger yields and improved oil extraction rates (OER). The improved labour situation in the oil palm plantation sector contributed to a 6.4% rise in fresh fruit bunch (FFB) yield of oil palm estates to 17.77 tonnes per hectare as against 16.70 tonnes per hectare achieved in the preceding year. Meanwhile, the national OER performance rose by a marginal of 0.4% to 19.74 percent vis-à-vis 19.67 percent in 2024 mainly due to a higher proportion of ripe/quality FFB processed by CPO producers.

On the other hand, Malaysia's palm oil exports reached 15.27 million tonnes in 2025, lower by 9.6% compared to 16.90 million tonnes recorded in 2024. India retained its position to be the Malaysia's largest export destination, maintaining its leading position for the twelfth consecutive year since 2014, importing 2.66 million tonnes or 17.4% of total Malaysian palm oil exports. Notably, Kenya emerged as the second-largest palm oil market, surpassing both the EU and China, with imports of 1.21 million tonnes (7.9%). Exports of palm oil to the EU stood at 1.03 million tonnes (6.8%), followed by China 0.90 million tonnes (5.9%), Türkiye 0.75 million tonnes (4.9%), the Philippines 0.72 million tonnes (4.7%) and Japan 0.59 million tonnes (3.9%). These seven (7) major combined markets accounted for 7.86 million tonnes or 51.5% of total Malaysian palm oil exports in 2025.

The average prices of oil palm products demonstrated an overall upward trend in 2025, supported primarily by firmer global soybean oil prices and positive market sentiment regarding Indonesia's planned implementation of B50 biodiesel mandate in 2026. The average CPO price rose by 2.7% to RM4,292.50 per tonne compared to RM4,179.50 per tonne in 2024. The average prices of palm kernel and CPKO increased significantly by 29.4% and 33.9%, reaching RM3,424.50 per tonne and RM7,329.50 per tonne, respectively, driven by supply tightness and stronger lauric oil prices in the global market. The average FFB price at 1% OER also increased by 5.4% to RM47.39 from RM44.98 in 2024, thus, improving the income levels of smallholders and estates. The firmer CPO price had resulted total export earnings rose by 2.8% to RM112.43 billion compared to RM109.39 billion attained in 2024.

Palm oil ending stocks reached 3.05 million tonnes, a significant 78.5% increase over the 1.71 million tonnes recorded in December 2024. This surge was driven by robust CPO production, which expanded by 4.9% (or 0.95 million tonnes), outpacing export that fell by 9.6% (or 1.63 million tonnes). Additionally, a sharp increase in imports by 3 folds (or 0.51 million tonnes) further contributing to the build-up in stocks.
